### **Catholic Alliance Behavior Guidelines**

1. Sts. Peter and Paul graciously accommodates our activities. When we are using any facility for a **CATHOLIC ALLIANCE** activity we need to conduct ourselves appropriately and follow the rules for Sts. Peter and Paul facilities. Children should be made aware that they should walk and speak quietly while in the buildings, outdoors they should stay in areas designated for walking, running and playing, and they should speak at all times with respect to all adults. We hope to be seen as good stewards who take good care of others' property and are welcomed back to each facility.

2. We will be using The Family Room this year for our group's activities. Please be aware that the Adoration Chapel is located directly across the double door entrance to the Family Room. Because of the presence of our Lord we should keep in mind to be respectful and as quiet as possible outside the Adoration Chapel. We will utilize the side entrance near the water fountains for entry and exit when possible. St. Mary's Hall and St. Ann's Hall are also facilities we may use at times. Please be aware that shoes with black soles can scuff the flooring. If at all possible please check your family's shoes for this problem. If scuffs are made you will need to clean them before leaving the hall. Children should stay away from the stacked chairs along the back wall and tables. Children should stay away from the cafeteria serving area and teacher drink table. We will designate areas to be used by **CATHOLIC ALLIANCE** for our activities.

3. Everyone attending an event needs to make sure that they clean up after themselves and their families. This includes cleaning up after ourselves when we are at an outdoor location such as a park or playground. Please do be the first to set the example, as they say, "Many hands make short work," and everyone can go home happy.

4. While we are all watching out for each other's children at each event, every parent needs to be diligent about keeping track of their children and their behavior. People generally are very uncomfortable when put in the position of correcting someone else's child. Toddlers and babies need to be especially watched for their safety and for the consideration of others. If your child becomes upset or needs attention please step outside so that others may continue to enjoy the activity.
